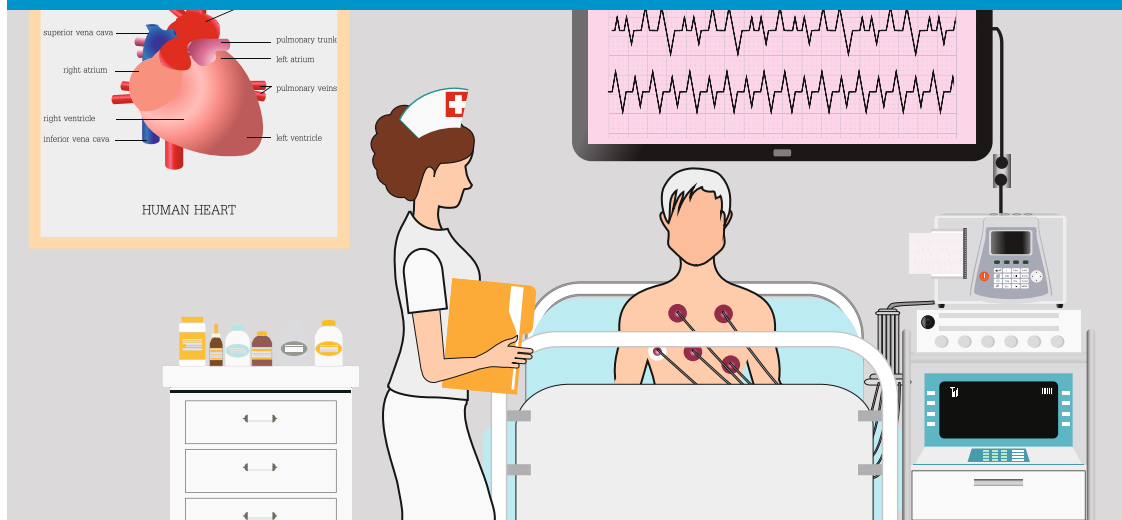


## ECG

**A simple, non-invasive procedure that records heart rate and its rhythms & is done to look or check for known heart conditions or how healthy the heart is before or after a surgery.**



- 1.** Inform your doctor what medicines you take as these might affect the test results.
- 2.** You are settled comfortably in an area where you need to remove your ornaments, accessories, purse, belt etc.
- 3.** The technologist will apply the conducting gel on the chest area and then attach electrodes on your chest, hands and legs. Wires connect the electrodes to the ECG machine.
- 4.** In case of female patients, this procedure is performed by a female technologist only.
- 5.** The procedure is completely painless and takes not more than 10 to 15 minutes.
- 6.** The machine will measure and record your heart's electrical activity and print out the results.
- 7.** The technologist will then remove the electrodes and wipe off the excess gel with tissues.
- 8.** Report will be issued soon after the procedure at the reception.
