

Intramuscular Injection – Paediatrics

An intramuscular injection is a technique used to deliver a medication deep into the muscles.



1. Carry the doctor's prescription, purchase the medicine from our pharmacy and come to the Pediatric Injection room.
2. In case, you are carrying your own medicine, a consent will be taken from you, before administering the injection.
3. Your child will be settled comfortably & the medicine that is being injected is shown and reconfirmed with you.
4. The site of injection is disinfected with an alcohol swab.
5. The nurse and team will also interact and distract the child with toys etc.
6. Your child will be kept under observation for 15 minutes for any reactions, in the waiting area.
7. The administered medicine is recorded with date of administration with staff signature, in your Out Patient file.
8. You are requested to monitor / keep a watch on the injection site after going home & in case of soreness / any unusual symptoms, please contact us immediately. However, this is very rare.
