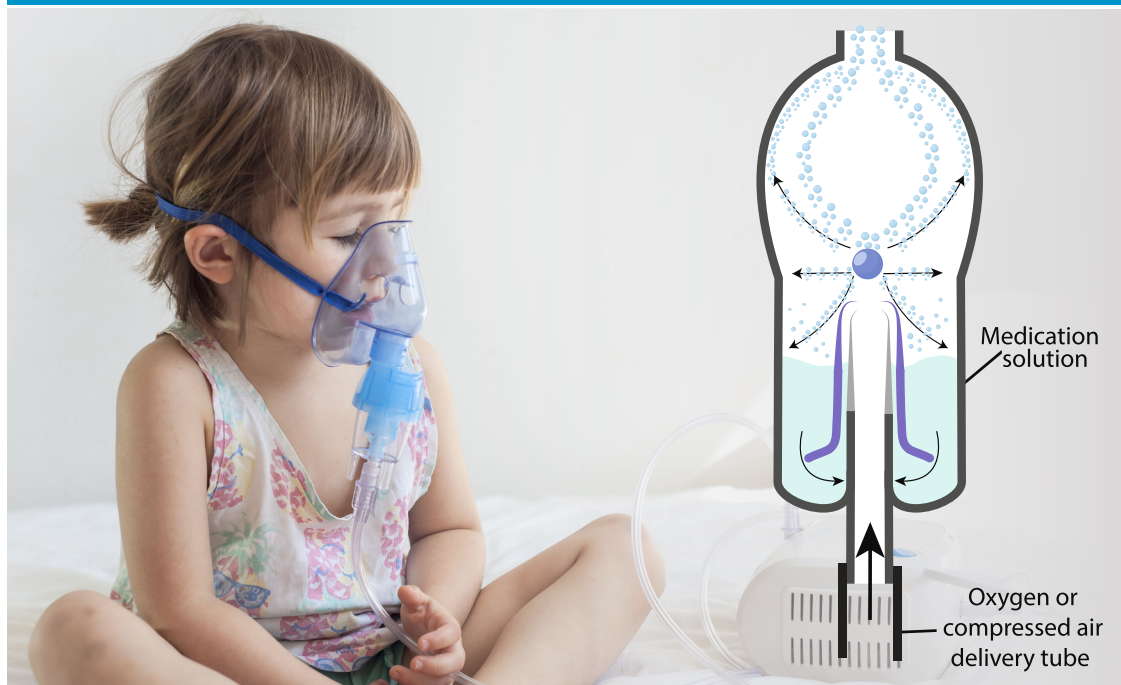


# NEBULIZATION IN PAEDIATRICS

Nebulization is the process of administering medication directly to the lungs via mist inhalation with the help of a nebulizer.



1. Carry the doctor's prescription.
2. Your child is settled comfortably in the Paediatric Emergency ward bed, where you and your child's privacy is respected throughout the procedure.
3. The medicine is added to the nebulization chamber.
4. The nebuliser mask is placed and secured around the child's nose and mouth.
5. The nebuliser has to be held in an upright position to prevent spilling and promote better inhalation.
6. The mask is removed after nebulization is completed.
7. Procedure will take 10-15 mins post which your child will be kept under observation for 10 minutes.
8. You will have to monitor the child after going home & in case of dry / sore mouth or throat, headache or rashes, please contact us immediately.
