

UROFLOWMETRY

Uroflometry measures urine volume voided over time, useful in clinical conditions, such as frequency and urgency incontinence, voiding difficulty, hesitancy or difficulty in maintaining the urine stream.



- 1.** Come with a reasonably full bladder before the procedure.
- 2.** You are settled comfortably in an area where your privacy is respected throughout the procedure
- 3.** The doctor and nurse will give you instructions and leave the room after which you may void urine into a special commode that measures the amount and rate of urine flow.
- 4.** Nurse will check if the void was typical. If you feel the void was atypical, the test will be repeated.
- 5.** This is a painless, non-invasive procedure that takes about 5 to 10 minutes.
- 6.** The report will be issued within 15 to 20 minutes, post procedure.
